STEP 1:

LAND PURCHASE

December 2015

The Diocese of Arlington buys a 28-acre parcel at Route 15 and Waterfall Road, Haymarket, VA. SKD parishioners raise funds to build a church.

GROUNDBREAKING CEREMONY

Bishop Burbidge will signal the start of the building process with a groundbreaking ceremony to be held on-site in early 2022.

PERMITTING, SITE WORK AND CONSTRUCTION

Site Plan submitted to PWC in October. Site Permit anticipated in May 2022. Site work begins late summer 2022. Construction of building begins in November 2022.

CORNERSTONE CAMPAIGN*

Although SKD can begin the building process, we need to raise an additional minimum of \$600,000 to complete the construction of our church.

*Payments can be made in support of the Cornerstone Campaign between November 1, 2021 - October 31, 2024.

Frequently Asked Questions

How long do I have to fulfill my pledge?

The SKD Cornerstone Campaign will run from November 1, 2021 - October 31, 2024. You can pay monthly, quarterly, annually, or make a one-time payment, whatever works best for your situation.

Why do I need to complete a pledge form?

The diocese will consider funds **pledged** through the SKD Cornerstone Campaign Pledge Form, as well as funds received, toward the attainment of our \$600,000 goal.

How much will it cost to build our church?

The projected cost of the St. Katharine Drexel Parish church is approximately \$7M.

Do you accept stock donations?

What if we raise more than \$600,000?

If we raise more than the minimum required, we will add more seating in the church and office space for the parish staff.

When will we have our first Mass at our new church?

We are expecting to complete construction of our church late fall 2023.
