In a couple of paragraphs, tell me about the Saint whose name you have chosen to take as your Confirmation name. Please include the information below in your report. More information is always a plus!

Your report may be handwritten or typed and 100-150 words minimum.

- What is it about this Saint that inspired you to take their name?
- What time period and where did the Saint live? When were they canonized?
- Share some interesting facts about the life of this Saint.
- Deeds & works for which your Saint is noted. Why are they a Saint?
- How will you use what you learned about this Saint to live out your faith?
