Incorporate the following reflection questions below to write about one of your service experience.

- Describe your service opportunity, how did you help others, how did it help you?
- What about your community involvement has been an eye-opening experience?
- Describe a person you encountered during your time of service who made a strong impression on you, positive or negative.
- How does this organization or group you helped address those needs?
- What were your reasons for choosing this particular type of service?
- What was your attitude toward service prior to beginning?
- During service, what were some of your thoughts and feelings about what you were doing?
- After completing the service project, what were some of your thoughts and feelings about service?
- Did this experience change your attitude toward service? Explain.
- How does the role of service relate to your faith in the life of a follower of Jesus?
